

What to buy for your new Tiger, Wolf or Bear Cub Scout (Use this list if your son is in 1st, 2nd or 3rd grade)

Uniform

Your cub will need a blue Cub Scout uniform and the patches that go on it. A uniform inspection sheet shows where the patches go and is included in the information packet. Uniforms may be purchased at the Scout Shop (at the council office on East Avenue see back for map). The choice of long or short sleeve is yours. We wear our pack t-shirts in the summer but those that attend Cub Adventure Camp need to wear their uniforms to dinner. Many of the boys have a short-sleeved shirt and just wear a long-sleeved t-shirt or thermal shirt underneath in the winter. We recommend that you buy a shirt that's a little big so your son gets at least two years wear out of it. Your son will also want a blue Cub Scout belt so he can wear any belt loops he earns.
